Top Tip:

Look out for words your child can use lots in their everyday life (e.g. sturdy, several, humorous, gallop, sprint, stroll, lather etc.)



Link new words to your child everyday life where those new words can make sense

For example;

'Let's **stack** your books up onto the shelf. put one on top of the other, that's it!'



Use these new word(s) throughout the day to help your child remember them.

For example;

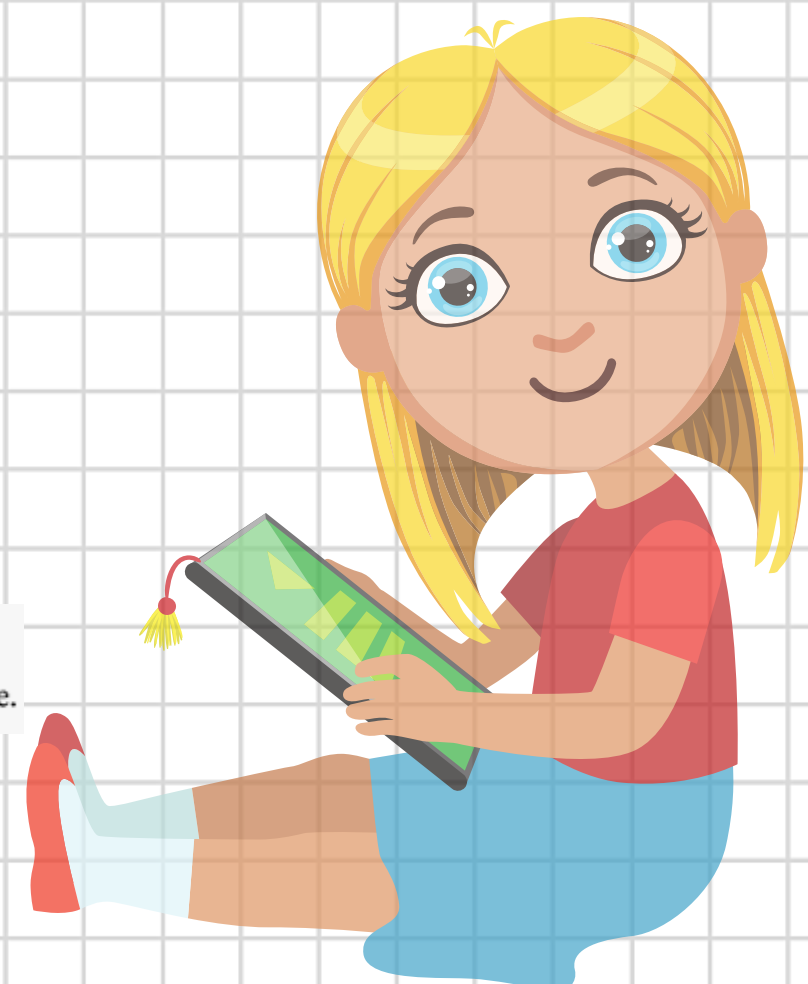
'Ollie, **stack** the dirty plates one on top of the other please. Then I'll carry them over to **stack** them in the dishwasher- you're a great help!'
